



A Call to Prayer for Mozambique Following the 2024 Elections and Post-Election

To: All Pastors, Leaders, and fellow Brothers and Sisters

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

As many of you know, the 2024 elections in Mozambique have resulted in significant political unrest and instability across the country. In the wake of these events, we are witnessing rising tensions, protests, violence, and widespread uncertainty about the future. Mozambique is at a crossroads, with deep societal divisions and the urgent need for divine intervention and reconciliation.

In this crisis, we, the body of Christ, are called to respond with faith, hope, and love. We are reminded in

2 Chronicles 7:14:

"If my people, who are called by my name, humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land."

This is a pivotal moment for us to intercede on behalf of the nation of Mozambique, trusting that prayer is powerful and effective in shaping history and bringing peace, healing, and restoration to the hearts and minds.

In such a time as this, let's apply God's words in

Philippians 4:6-7:

"Do not worry about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God. ⁷ And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."

I am inviting every pastor, leader, and brother and sister in the church in Mozambique, across our region and beyond, to join in a **10-day Prayer** beginning Wednesday, **November 13, 2024, to Friday, November 22, 2024**, to intercede for Mozambique and its people fervently.

10-day prayer guide for Mozambique after the 2024 election and political instability

"If my people who are called by my name humble themselves, and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sin and heal their land" – 2 Chronicles 7:14

Following the 2024 elections in Mozambique, which triggered political instability, demonstrations and social unrest, this 10-day prayer guide invites the body of Christ to unite in fervent prayer for the nation. Although political unrest brings division and fear, the power of prayer is greater than any earthly authority. As followers of Jesus, we are called to intercede for healing, reconciliation and peace in our land. This prayer guide follows the pattern of the Lord's Prayer and is designed to help us pray for the restoration of Mozambique in a time of volatility and uncertainty.

Day 1: November 13, 2024 - "Our Father"

Focus: Declaration of God's Sovereignty over Mozambique. As Mozambique faces the challenges of post-election unrest, today we declare God's sovereignty as Father over this nation. Pray for peace in all regions, for the safety of all citizens and for wisdom in handling the political crisis. Ask God to cover all areas of life - polling stations, government institutions and communities affected by the instability.

Prayer: *God, we declare your love and sovereignty over Mozambique. Bless our nation, heal the divisions and restore peace to our land. God, pour out your grace on Mozambique.*

Day 2: November 14, 2024 - "Hallowed be His Name"

Focus: Worshipping God for His Sovereignty amid Chaos. Regardless of the outcome of the elections, we affirm that Jesus is Lord of all, and His throne remains unshakable. We recognize that amid turmoil, there is only one true King - God. Declare God's name holy over the land of Mozambique. Worship Him for His power to bring order, justice and peace in the face of uncertainty.

Prayer: *Lord, we declare that your name is holy over Mozambique. We honor you, not only in times of peace, but especially in times of conflict. You are sovereign and reign overall.*

Day 3: November 15, 2024 - "Your Kingdom Come"

Focus: Praying for God's Kingdom to come in Mozambique. Pray for the Kingdom to be established in the political, social and economic life of Mozambique. In times when kingdoms and political systems are in turmoil, pray that God's kingdom - marked by justice, mercy and truth - will come with power and transformation. Pray for the hearts of leaders to turn to God's righteous will.

Prayer: *Father, may Your Kingdom come in Mozambique. May our political systems, our government and our society reflect the justice, mercy and righteousness of Your eternal Kingdom.*

Day 4: November 16, 2024 - "Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven"

Focus: Praying for God's will to be done on earth. Today, pray for God's will to be done on earth as it is in heaven, especially in Mozambique. Ask for a transformation in the hearts of leaders and citizens, so that they seek God's righteousness, peace and justice in all their actions. Pray that the values of the Kingdom - humility, mercy and reconciliation - will replace the divisions and violence that are tearing at the fabric of the nation.

Prayer: *Lord, may your will be done in Mozambique - on earth as it is in heaven. Bring peace, reconciliation and justice to our land. May Your kingdom reign here.*

Day 5: November 17, 2024 - "Give us this day our daily bread"

Focus: Praying for provision and peace amidst uncertainty in times of instability, many facing economic hardship. Pray for God's provision for the people of Mozambique, especially for those affected by instability - those who are destitute, displaced or suffering loss. Pray that the country's economy will recover, and that God's people will be a witness to His provision in a needy world.

Prayer: *Father, provide for the people of Mozambique today. Meet their physical, emotional and spiritual needs. May Your mercy and provision be evident to all, especially the most vulnerable.*



Day 6: November 18, 2024 - "Forgive us our debts"

Focus: Confession and national repentance. Mozambique, like every nation, has sins to confess. Today, take time to confess personal and corporate sins before God - pride, greed, corruption, idolatry, violence and injustice. Pray for God's mercy to cleanse our nation of the sins that have led to division, unrest and suffering.

Prayer: *God, we confess our sins as a nation. Forgive us for our corruption, idolatry and the ways in which we have failed to seek justice and peace. Heal our land, Lord, and restore us to righteousness.*

Day 7: November 19, 2024 - "as we forgive our debtors"

Focus: Extending forgiveness for healing and reconciliation. Forgiveness is a powerful tool for reconciliation and healing, both personally and nationally. Today, ask God to help us forgive those who offend us or have caused us harm during political instability. Pray that forgiveness will flow freely in the hearts of all citizens, especially between opposing political groups, ethnic divisions and crisis-affected regions.

Prayer: *Lord, help us to forgive, just as you have forgiven us. Free our hearts from bitterness and anger and bring reconciliation and healing to Mozambique.*

Day 8: November 20, 2024 - "Lead us not into temptation."

Focus: Praying for victory over temptation and sin. In times of crisis, the temptation to sin can increase - whether it's the temptation to retaliate, act out of fear or give in to despair. Pray for strength to overcome sin and for wisdom for the leaders and people of Mozambique, so that they resist the temptation to pursue their own agendas at the expense of peace. Pray for a spirit of unity to arise, grounded in God's love and righteousness.

Prayer: *Lord, do not lead us into temptation. Give us wisdom to resist the temptations of division, violence and sin. Help us to walk in Your light and righteousness.*

Day 9: November 21, 2024 - "Deliver us from evil and the evil one"

Focus: Praying against the forces of evil. Today we take a stand against the forces of evil that seek to divide, destroy and deceive in Mozambique. Pray for deliverance from the evil one who seeks to sow confusion and fear. Bind the powers of darkness that are driving the unrest and declare Christ's victory over sin, corruption and violence in Mozambique.

Prayer: *Father, free Mozambique from the forces of evil. In the name of Jesus, we bind every work of darkness and declare victory over corruption, violence and division in this land.*

Day 10: November 22nd - "Yours is the Kingdom, the Power and the Glory"

Focus: Giving glory and trusting in the Sovereignty of God. On this last day, we proclaim that God is sovereign, and His Kingdom will never be shaken. We trust in His goodness, mercy and justice. Even in times of uncertainty, we declare that God's Kingdom is eternal, and His power is greater than any political or social force. Praise God for his ability to heal, restore and redeem.

Prayer: *Lord, Yours is the Kingdom, yours is the power and Yours is the Glory forever and ever. We place Mozambique in Your hands, trusting that You are in control and we give all the Glory to You.*
